

Custer at Gettysburg Speaker: Jim Hessler



As a prelude to our Annual PKCWRT Fall Trip to Gettysburg on Nov 5th, Jim Hessler (LBG) will give us a detailed briefing before we set foot onto East Cavalry Field with his online Zoom Custer at Gettysburg presentation.

Brash newly minted 23 year old General George Armstrong Custer usually draws strong opinions on either side, love him or hate him. At Gettysburg on that hot summer day of July 3rd, 1863, Custer, with his force of Michigan Wolverines fought valiantly and intensely to add to Custer's reputation. Matched against the South's General JEB Stuart forces who showed up late to Gettysburg and tried to make an impact. For 40 minutes the two sides clashed with sabers, pistols, and carbines. Although it was short, it was extremely intense. This Cavalry battle is often overlooked and related to a footnote in the overall Battle of Gettysburg however it is no less important in Lee's attempt to break General Meade's Army of the Potomac and hope to turn the tide of the war.

Our Speaker, Jim Hessler is well known to the PKCWRT as he has spoken and guided us throughout the years. Jim is a Licensed Battlefield Guide at Gettysburg National Military Park. His 2009 book, Sickles at Gettysburg, was awarded the R.E. Lee Civil War Round Table's Bachelder Coddington Award and the Gettysburg Civil War Round Table's Distinguished Book Award as the most outstanding work on the Gettysburg Campaign. He has co-authored, Pickett's Charge at Gettysburg with Wayne Motts as well as the Gettysburg Peach Orchard: Longstreet, Sickles, and the Bloody Fight for the "Commanding Ground" Along the Emmitsburg Road with Brett isenberg. He is a popular author and speaker at civil war round tables who has taught courses for the Gettysburg Foundation and Harrisburg (PA) Area Community College. He lives in Gettysburg with his wife and children. Jim is also co-hosts the popular podcast" The Battle Of Gettysburg with Eric Lindblade (LBG).



You can secure a signed copy by going to bellegrovepublishingco.com. This book won't be available on Amazon until October 2022 (even though Amazon claims September 19th is the release date). Amazon is selling the book for \$45, however there is no indication if Amazon Prime members get free shipping https://www.amazon.com/General-Philip-Kearny-Very-God/dp/1883926165. This hard cover book has 880 pages, includes color pages, footnotes, an index and weighs in at 5.3 lbs! It's a heavy book packed with lots of history thus why the shipping costs.
