Gen. Grant's Concepts of Leadership in Taking Tennessee: The Strategic Operations that Secured Shiloh

Presented by Dr. Heidi Amelia-Anne Weber

Dr. Heidi Amelia-Anne Weber, a noted historian and military scholar, delves into the strategic insights and bold leadership of Major General Ulysses S. Grant during the pivotal Battle of Shiloh. Although Grant had not anticipated facing a Confederate attack, he quickly adapted to the surprise engagement with decisive leadership and a strategic mindset that defied conventional military norms.

Dr. Weber will explore how Grant, facing an outnumbered Union force, chose to stay on the front lines, utilizing his determination and strategic vision to launch a critical counteroffensive. This turning point not only secured a Union victory but also paved the way

for advances into Mississippi, ultimately contributing to the division of the Confederacy. Through a nuanced analysis, Dr. Weber sheds light on Grant's unconventional decision-making and its impact on the Union's broader objectives, offering insights beyond traditional battle descriptions.

Dr. Weber holds a Ph.D. in 19th-Century American History from Kent State University and serves as a full professor of military history at SUNY: Orange. Her published works include her recent book, "Like a Great Feudal Landlord": How Architecture and Slavery Created the World of the Upcountry Planter, as well as contributions to The World of Antebellum America: A Daily Life




General Ulysses S. Grant

Encyclopedia, The Handbook of Military Administration, and The Encyclopedia of Gettysburg. Among her accolades, Dr. Weber was awarded the SUNY: Orange President's Award for Excellence in Teaching and the New York Chancellor's Award for Teaching Excellence. She is also active in numerous historical organizations and serves as a Service Academy Interview Screener for New Jersey Senators.

This presentation promises an engaging exploration of the strategic foresight and leadership qualities that defined one of Grant's early and significant victories in the Civil War.




